Before we start with co-curricular achievements, I would like to proudly announce that our previous first board batch of Std-XII students, brought us 100% result with 14 of them securing above 85%, 30 of them securing above 80% and 44 of them securing above 75% out of 114 students. Similarly our previous board batch of Std-X students, brought us 100% result with 10 of them securing above 90% and 48 of them securing above 80% out of 162 students.
